Clubman Sports Cars are open top sports cars that evolved from cars like the Colin Chapman designed Lotus 7, and many others such as Lola Climax. New Zealand designed and built cars like the beautiful little Redline (RPC), Beattie, Fraser, Chevron, Leitch, McGregor all feature in the class as do other top marques such as Lotus, Caterham and Westfield.

“Don’t be fooled by the “Clubman” label and the size of these cars,” says Trev, “as they are very quick indeed and often sit near the top of the lap time charts at any race event.”
